Crossrail Project Development Agreement (“PDA”) – Adverse Event Notice

In accordance with clause 22 of the PDA, we write to notify you of the following Adverse Event which will have a material adverse impact on the Crossrail Project:

There is insufficient time to carry out the full range of integrated testing of the railway required to introduce Stage 3 Elizabeth line services in December 2018 because additional time is required to complete fitting-out the central tunnels and for development of reliable railway systems software packages.

Pursuant to clause 22.2, CRL notifies you that it intends to develop a Remedial Action Plan, in consultation with the Sponsors, to address the consequences of the Adverse Event and its impact on planned opening dates for Stages 3, 4 and 5.
